I am having the same problem.

I am running my Joomla installations on a VPS with CentOS 4.6 / PHP 5.1.6 / Mysql 5.0.27 on Apache 2.0.59

I am running the latest version of PHPlist and have been using it for 3 years without a problem.

When I configure the module and component, and I try to enter a name and e-mail I see the rotating logo for half a second and then it disappears. The module is then empty, and there is no user subscribed or user added to the list.

My PHPlist installation is in another vhost directory than my Joomla installations and I use the absolute path. To be sure I chmod the directory /lists/ to 777.

My database user for Joomla and PHPlist is the same.

Any help would be greatly appreciated!
