- b) List ID had to be 2 or higher to work as test list used up first ID
- c) Db user naming issue- fun with hosted sites!

looks like i fell at every fence :silly:

Anyhoo- what I'm having issues with now is, the subscription emails show xml tags for line-break {lessthan}br /{greaterthan} at the start of every @#&\*% line whether I check plain-text or html. I've tried typing directly into the text entry box, pasting from notepad; apart from sending one long unbroken line of text, nothing works. I'm using smtp rather than PHPMailer function.
